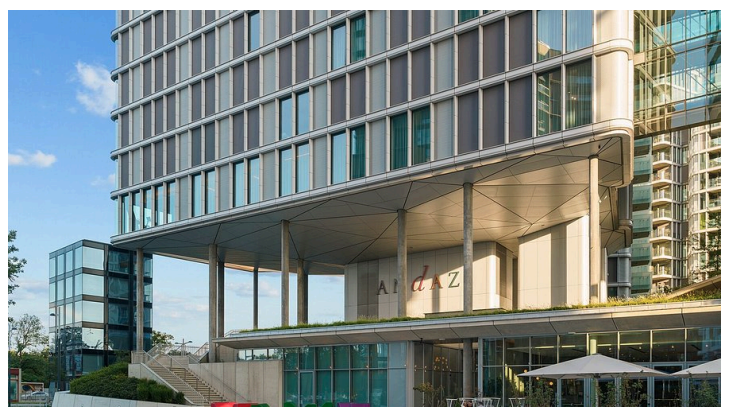

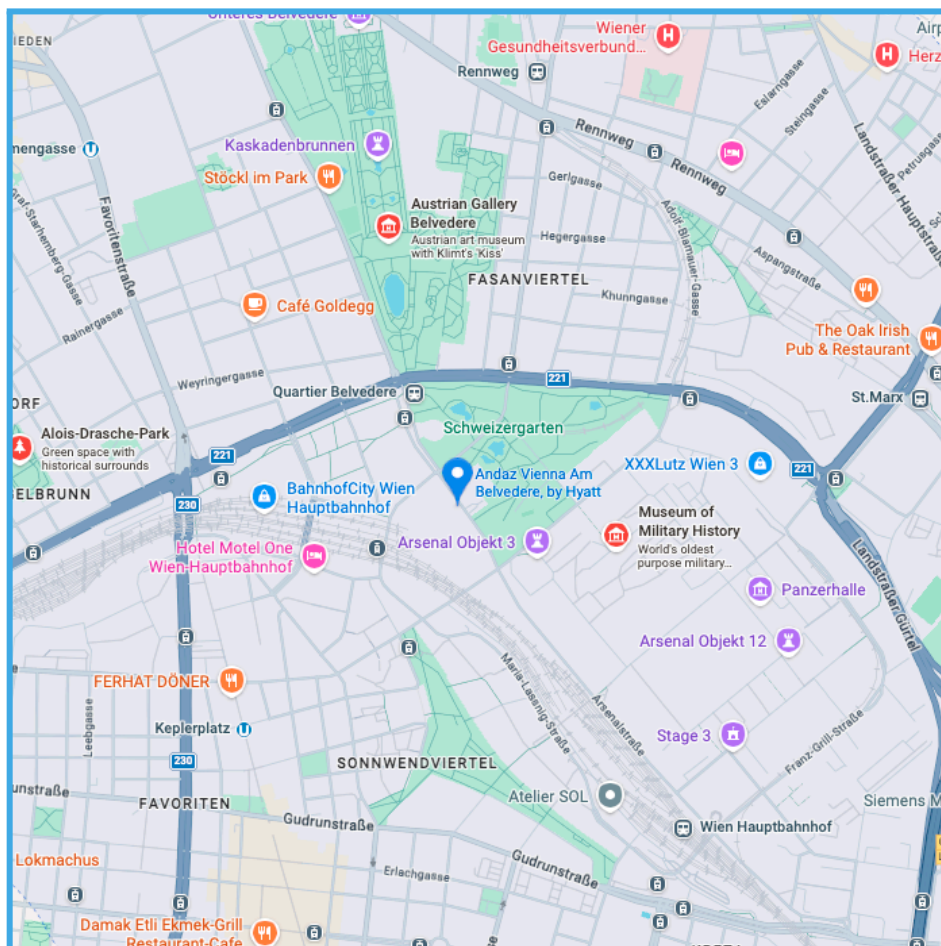

The conference hotel is conveniently located next to **Wien Hauptbahnhof (Vienna Central Station)** and near the **Belvedere Palace** and **Stadtpark**.

Please note that from April 13, 2026 the Andaz Vienna Am Belvedere will rebrand and become the Hyatt Regency Vienna.



GETTING AROUND IN VIENNA

From Vienna Airport (Flughafen Wien)

As our venue (the [Andaz/Hyatt Regency](#)) is next to **Wien Hauptbahnhof (Vienna Central Station)**, reaching the hotel is simple and inexpensive by public transport. The name of the station is often abbreviated to **Wien Hbf**.

- **ÖBB Railjet**
 - Direct trains run from **Flughafen Wien** to **Wien Hauptbahnhof (Hbf)** in around 20 minutes, via the [ÖBB Railjet](#) network (which also connects Vienna to other European cities).
 - Tickets cost around €5 and can be purchased at the ÖBB ticket counters in the Arrivals Hall, at station vending machines, in the Tourist Office, or via the [ÖBB Railjet app](#).
 - Check the [ÖBB website](#) for schedules
- **Alternatives**
 - [Vienna Airport Busline 1](#) is an economical route by road
 - The **S-Bahn** is also an option, however there are no direct trains from the airport to **Wien Hauptbahnhof**. If taking the S-Bahn use the [S7 line](#) and change at **Wien Rennweg Bahnst.**
 - The dedicated [CAT \(City Airport Train\)](#) is more expensive and only travels directly between the airport and **Wien Mitte-Landstraße** station so connections would be required.

Public Transportation

Vienna's public transportation network is very well developed. You can travel quickly and reliably by subway (S-Bahn), streetcar/tram, and bus.

Please visit [Vienna's official travel guide](#) for full details. They recommend using the [WienMobil app](#) for all routes in the city.

Taxi

Transfer from Vienna Airport to the venue by taxi in approximately 20 minutes, with average fares falling between €30–€45. Taxis are located at the taxi stands outside the terminal.

Once in the city, there are ranks located outside **Wien Hauptbahnhof (Central Station)** (or the helpful staff at the hotel venue can also assist). Expect a fare of roughly €15–€20+ for short city trips, with options for cash or card payments.

For app-based rides, **Uber and Bolt** operate frequently in Vienna, including from the airport.

Walking

Vienna is a very walkable city, especially in the historic city centre.



LOCAL INFORMATION

Currency

The Euro (€) is the official currency of Austria. Payment methods accepted in the country include:

- Cash, especially for smaller purchases.
- Debit/Credit Cards: Visa, Mastercard, and American Express are commonly accepted, particularly in larger establishments.
- Digital Wallets: Digital wallets like PayPal and Apple Pay are also an option - most businesses that accept Visa and Mastercard contactless payments will accept Apple Pay.

Voltage

As in most of Europe, the standard voltage in Austria is 230V with a frequency of 50Hz. If your electrical devices are designed to operate at a different voltage (e.g., 110V or 127V), you will need a voltage converter to safely use them in Vienna.

Austrian sockets are typically the two-pin [Type F or Type C](#), so you may need travel adapters.

Languages spoken

Austrian Standard German is the official language of Austria. English is also widely spoken and understood. Vienna is the English version of the city's name; in German it is "Wien."

Visa information

Citizens of countries outside the [Schengen Area](#) and those without visa-waiver agreements with the Schengen Area will likely need a visa to enter Austria, especially if travelling from Asia, Africa, and parts of South America. Learn more about Schengen visas [here](#).

HEALTH & SAFETY

Safety and security

Vienna is generally a safe place to visit, but as with any other major city, stay aware of your surroundings and be vigilant with your belongings.

Emergencies

Phone numbers:

- Fire service: **122** (24hrs)
- General Practitioners Out-of-hours service: **141**
 - Weekdays: 7 pm to 7 am
 - Weekends: 7 pm (Friday) to 7 am (Monday)
 - Public holidays: 24 hours a day
- Police: **133** (24 hrs)

Medical Care

The closest hospital with a central emergency department is the [Klinik Landstraße - Wiener Gesundheitsverbund](#) (approx. 2km from the venue).

At the event, the hotel's Event Supervisor is the first point of contact for any emergencies that should arise. If medical attention is required, SNOMED International will have a defibrillator and first aid kit at the **registration desk**, and a number of the organization's staff members are certified to use these devices.

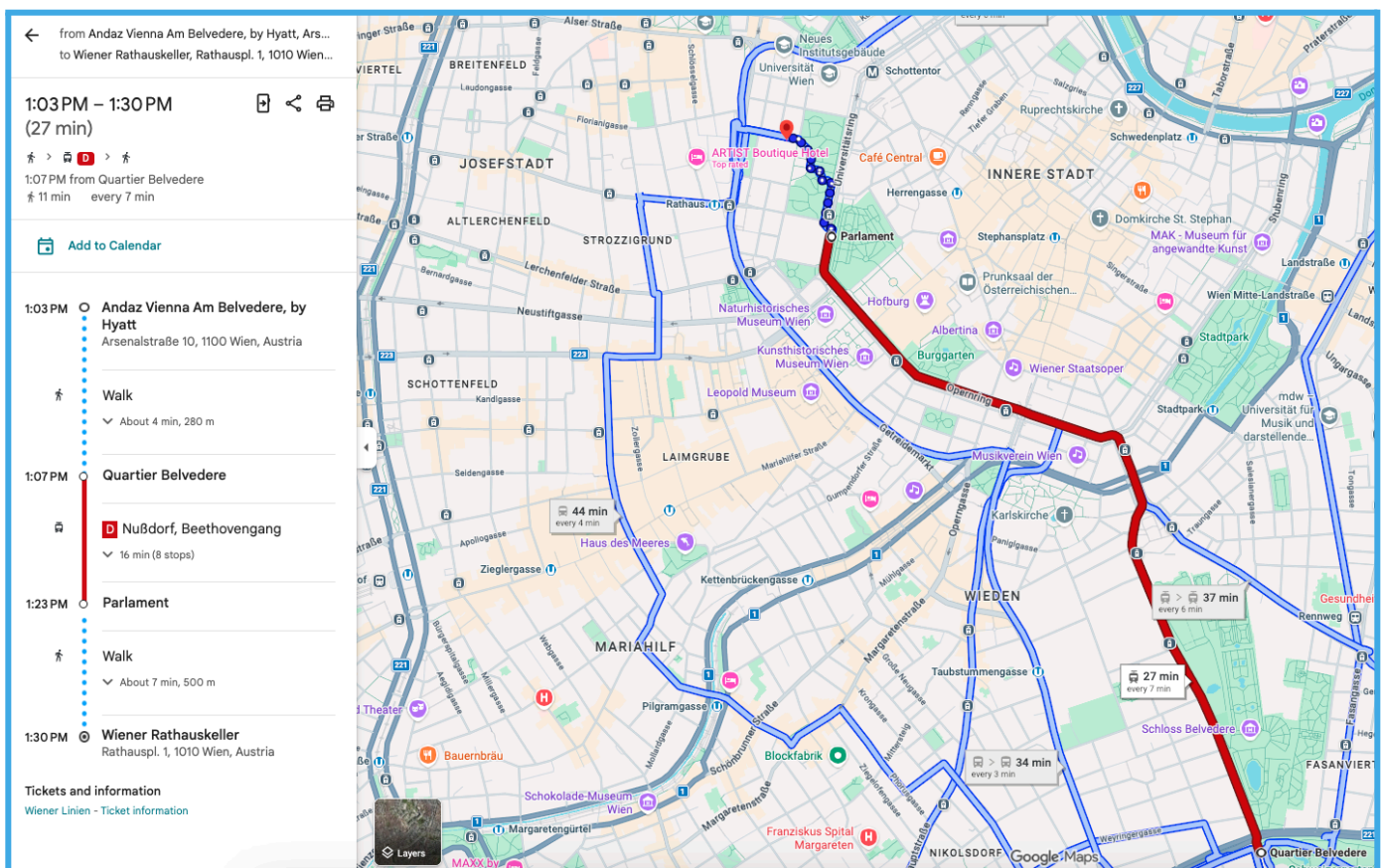
- **When:** Monday, April 13, 2026 from 18:00-19:30

- **Getting there:** From the Andaz/Hyatt Regency Vienna, the Rathauskeller can be reached in approximately 30 minutes by taking **tram line D**. The tram ride goes along Vienna's famous Ringstraße, one of the city's most beautiful and historic boulevards, so the travel time will be a nice sightseeing experience.

- Start: **Andaz Vienna Am Belvedere/Hyatt Regency Vienna**
- Short walk to: **Quartier Belvedere**
- Tram: **Line D**
- Exit at: **Rathausplatz (Parlament)**
- Short walk to: **Wiener Rathauskeller**

Adjacent to the venue, the [BahnhofCity Mall](#) at Wien Hauptbahnhof (Central Station) includes a wide range of convenient retail shops, restaurants & supermarkets, as you would expect at a major train station.

Heading further into town, [Vienna's eateries](#) offer the entire spectrum of regional and international restaurants. Be sure to try dining at a typical Viennese "Beisl" (tavern), or enjoy the famous [Viennese Coffeehouse culture!](#)

Vienna offers [shopping pleasure to suit every taste](#). The largest and most lively shopping street is Mariahilfer Strasse. If you take a detour into the side streets, you'll discover a vast array of original shops and stores.
